C) Supplementary Regulations

7.2 Quantity of tyres (update)

Tyres for all drivers except WRC cars drivers must comply with Article 62.1 of the 2014 WRC Sporting Regulations. all competitors entered with an S2000-Rally Car / all competitors entered with R5 and R4 cars / all Priority drivers entered with a Group N car must comply with Article 62.1 of the 2014 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations. For these competitors the maximum quantity of tyres for the entire event will be 20 (4 tyres x 5 changes).

For the WRC cars drivers the maximum quantity of tyres for the entire event will be 28 25 (4 5 tyres x ≩ 5 changes).

4 extra tyres will be added for competitors who undertake the shakedown.

D) Supplementary Regulations

7.5.3 (new)

Drivers using competing cars for the reconnaissance of SSS1-Città di Cagliari are authorized to use gravel tyres.

E) Supplementary Regulations

11.8 SSS1-Città di Cagliari - Fitting and use of extra lights (new) For P1, P2 and P3 drivers, the fitting of extra lights is mandatory. These extra lights must remain switched off during SSS1, unless otherwise authorised by the Clerk of the Course. Any infringement will be reported to the Stewards.

F) Supplementary Regulations

12.8 Power Stage (update)

Any car selected by the Organiser, in conjunction with WRC Promoter, may start Section 7 and SS 17 in an order and a starting interval between the cars as determined by the Clerk of the course. The rest of the competitors will start Section 7 and/or SS17 in the order and with the intervals at TC 16B and/or TC17.

12.8.1 Interviews at SS17 Power Stage STOP Control (new)

For the purpose of Live TV there will be interviews at the STOP control of the stage. The Organisers, in conjunction with WRC Promoter, may stop any car and its crew on the road section immediately after the STOP control of the stage, so that they can take part in media interviews and a made-for-TV podium ceremony. These crews will be directed by Marshals at the STOP control of the stage. If necessary, additional time for the road section to TC 21A will be given by an official at this location on the time card.
